- Papers must be written in English. Submissions should be at most **14 pages** long including references and appendices.
- Submissions should **not be anonymized**.
- PC members are not required to read the appendices, so the paper should be intelligible without them.
- The papers have to be submitted via EasyChair conference system. The submission Web page for SEC 2018 is <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=sec2018>
- Submitted papers must be **original, unpublished, and not submitted to another** conference or journal for consideration. The authors have to follow the **Springer LNCS formatting instructions** (see instructions for Word and LaTeX2e templates at:
<http://www.springer.com/gp/computer-science/lncs/conference-proceedings-guidelines>
- Each paper will receive at least 4 reviews.
- Accepted papers will be presented at the conference and included in the conference **proceedings published in the IFIP AICT series** of the official IFIP publisher: Springer Nature.
- After the conference, extended versions of **selected papers** will be considered for publication in the journals Computers and Security and International Journal of Critical Infrastructure Protection. Those papers will undergo at least another review round.
- At least **one author of each accepted paper must register** to the conference by the early date indicated by the organizers, and present the paper.
